WHAT TO EXPECT DURING A

STORM

When a winter storm blows into town it's everyone's responsibility to do their part. This chart will help you remember what is expected of you when the snowflakes start to fall!



How much snow has fallen?

Patrol data

Municipal staff are called in.

2.5 CM



Storm begins!

Sand/Salt operations begin on all arterial roads, i.e. Baseline to OPG.



7.5 CM



Sand/Salt all Municipal roads

Deployment of all operations staff to plow municipal roads and streets



7.5 CM



Sidewalk/ Parking Lot maintenance

Immediate call out of contractors with snow accumulation of 7.5 CM or more.



7.5 CM



Plowing Operations

Plowing is rated in priority.

Priority of Removal

- 1 Urban
- 2 Rural
- 3 Residential

60 CM



Clean up Operations

Snow removal operations are initiated at 60 CM of snow depth.

Priority of Removal

- 1 Business Improvement Areas and Council approved roadways
- 2 Intersections
- 3 Cul de Sac's

Time to clear snow accumulation

*NOTE: All times start at the end of accumulation.

12 Hours or until storm ends

Snow: 12-24 Hours
Ice: 8-16 Hours

24 Hours to completion or storm ends

Priority of Removal

- 1 12-24 Hrs. - Urban areas
- 2 12-24 Hrs. - Rural areas
- 3 24 Hrs. - All areas

24-48 Hours
